NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids will be received by the City of Coon Rapids at the office of the City Clerk until **10:00 a.m. local time, Thursday, March 14, 2019**, at the Coon Rapids City Hall, 11155 Robinson Drive, Coon Rapids, MN 55433, and will be publicly opened and read at said time and place by representatives of the City of Coon Rapids. Said proposals for the furnishing of all labor and materials for the construction, complete in-place, of the following:

The work includes, but is not limited to, general earthwork, removal of pavement, storm sewer and vegetation, new bituminous trails, new concrete pavement and curbs, storm sewer, electrical, athletic courts, picnic shelters, landscaping, seeding, irrigation, and site restoration.

The provisions of Minn. Stat. 16C.285 Responsible Contractor are imposed as a requirement of this contract. All bidders and persons or companies providing a response/submission to the Advertisement for Bids/RFP of the City shall comply with the provisions of the statute.

The bids must be submitted on the Proposal Forms provided in accordance with the Contract Documents, Plans, and Specifications dated February 5, 2019, as prepared by WSB, which are on file with the City Clerk of Coon Rapids and may be seen at the office of the Consulting Engineer.

Complete digital Proposal Forms, Plans, and Specifications for use by Contractors submitting a bid are available at www.questcdn.com. You may download the digital plan documents for a nonrefundable fee of \$30.00 by inputting Quest project #6119825 on the website's Project Search page.

Bids will only be accepted from Contractors who purchase Bidding Documents as specified above.

No bids will be considered unless sealed and filed with the City Clerk of Coon Rapids and accompanied by a cash deposit, cashier's check, or certified check, or bid bond made payable to the City of Coon Rapids for five percent (5%) of the amount bid, to be forfeited as liquidated damages in the event that the bid be accepted and the bidder fail to enter promptly into a written contract and furnish the required bond.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all Bids, waive any informalities in bidding or to accept the Bid or Bids, which best serve the interests of the Owner.

No bids may be withdrawn for a period of 60 days from the date of opening of bids. The City of Coon Rapids reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
