Immediately following expiration of the time for receiving bids, representatives of the City of Rogers will publicly view bids at the office of the City Clerk at the Rogers City Hall located at 22350 South Diamond Lake Road, Rogers, MN 55374. The Project includes the furnishing of all labor and materials for the construction, complete in-place, of the following approximate quantities:

12,500	S Y	Bituminous Pavement Reclamation
7,000	S Y	Mill Bituminous Pavement
4,100	TON	Bituminous Wear and Non-Wear Courses
2,100	L F	Concrete Curb and Gutter Miscellaneous Restoration

The provisions of MINN. STAT. 16C.285 Responsible Contractor are imposed as a requirement of this contract. All bidders and persons or companies providing a response/submission to the Advertisement for Bids of the City of Rogers shall comply with the provisions of the statute.
