DESCRIPTION OF WORK: The project includes the furnishing of all labor and materials for the construction complete in-place, of the following approximate quantities: 3 ACRE CLEARING AND GRUBBING; 32000 SF REMOVE BITUMINOUS WALK; 5100 CY EXCAVATION – COMMON (P); 1600 CY AGGREGATE BASE (CV) CLASS 5 (P); 1000 SF MODULAR BLOCK RETAINING WALL; 49000 SF 3” BITUMINOUS WALK.
